Dear Valued Customer,

At Analog Devices, customer success is the focal point of our business, and I am pleased to share that we are upgrading our legacy Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) systems to the industry-leading SAP S/4Hana platform, providing our sales teams better visibility to improve your ADI experience – from initial order creation through shipment and invoice – so that we can more efficiently service your needs.

We have carefully planned this implementation to minimize any risk to our customers and impact to supply continuity. To facilitate a smooth cutover to the new system, **we are implementing a shipping blackout period from November 18 to November 26, 2023. ADI will not be shipping any orders during this time. In addition, while you can continue to place orders, we will be unable to acknowledge or schedule new orders until after the blackout period.**

Our team members may be in contact with you directly in the coming weeks to request the pull-in of your request date by 3-4 weeks. Whenever possible, we will strive to ship orders in alignment with your request date.

In addition, since you are a customer who has bought Maxim Integrated products, it is important that you know we are consolidating legal entities as part of our ERP transition, and this may impact your order placement and invoicing. This will only affect parts you bought in the past from Maxim Integrated. There is no impact on current and future purchases of Analog Devices products. Please note the following legal entities and banking details to use effective November 18, 2023 for any Maxim Integrated products:

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Existing Orders and instructions for New Order Placement

In October 2023, all non-US Maxim Integrated customer contracts and orders will transfer to Analog Devices International UC, but Maxim Integrated will continue to manage and service these contracts and orders on Analog Devices International UC's behalf until November 26, 2023. You do not need to take any action during this period and your contracts and orders will operate as normal, we are simply notifying you of the change in your contract counterparty from October 2023.

On November 18, 2023, open orders that were placed prior to this date but have not yet shipped will be converted automatically to the new entities. Please ensure you have bank details set up in your systems to reflect the details provided above.

Unless we hear from you before September 1, 2023, with different instructions, we will assume we have your consent to convert your backlog as part of our SAP S4/HANA go-live plan. You do not need to do anything else.

If, due to systems or policy limitations, your company needs to provide new purchase order numbers, please inform your ADI sales contact for further instructions. We will need to receive replacement purchase order details before October 1, 2023. If you place orders via Electronic Data Interchange (EDI), there will be no changes to current connections or maps.

ADI is committed to making this transition as seamless as possible while maintaining a resilient supply chain to enable your continued success. To address immediate questions, we've developed a **Frequently Asked Questions** document for your reference on the next page. 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Here are some **Frequently Asked Questions** which may address some of your immediate questions.

What is the date of the purchasing change?

Beginning **November 18, 2023**, you must place all new orders for Maxim parts under the legal entities noted above.

What if I place an order for a Maxim Integrated part before November 18?

Any order for Maxim parts placed prior to November 18 must be placed via the current process. We will not be able to accept any purchase orders for Maxim Integrated parts in the new ADI system before November 18. Any orders you place cannot be entered, scheduled, or shipped.

What is the last day I should direct my purchase orders to Maxim Integrated?

We ask that you place your last order directed to Maxim Integrated before November 18. While we transition to a new ERP system, we will have a short shipping blackout period between November 18-26. During the blackout, we will not acknowledge or schedule new orders. You are still able to place an order, and it will be processed after the blackout period ends.

Do I need to change my existing orders that are in place with Maxim Integrated?

We plan to move all existing backlog to ADI's new order management system beginning on November 18. We will retain your existing PO number, customer request dates, schedule dates and pricing. During the week of November 27, your customer service representative can provide you with an open order report detailing your combined ADI and Maxim Integrated backlog.

If you need to change your purchase order number, please work with your customer service representative.

What if I place an order to Maxim Integrated after November 18?

We will not be able to accept any purchase orders addressed to Maxim Integrated from November 18 onward. Your customer service person will work with you to get a new purchase order placed that is addressed to Analog Devices.

What if I want to cancel some backlog?

ADI and Maxim Integrated operate according to the same Terms and Conditions. Cancellation terms are identical. If you have any questions, please contact your customer service representative.

What if I place orders both direct and through distribution today?

You still have the option to place your orders directly or through an authorized distributor.

Do I need to create a new supplier number (vendor number)?

How you set up vendors in your system is dependent on your internal processes and policies. Effective November 18, you must transact with Analog Devices Inc or Analog Devices International UC only. If you maintain separate vendors in your system, please ensure that the legal entities, addresses and remittance information are identical.

Who will the invoice be from?

From November 18 onward, all invoices will be from Analog Devices Inc. or Analog Devices International UC.

What are the terms of sale?

ADI and Maxim Integrated operate according to the same Terms and Conditions. Cancellation terms are identical. If you have any questions, please contact your customer service representative.

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Are there any currency changes?

All transactions will be in US dollars.

Where will my parts ship from?

We will be using the same warehouse locations we have today. The Maxim Integrated parts will ship from the Philippines or Thailand.

Will there be any changes to the parts?

There will be no immediate changes. If there are any changes in the future, ADI will use the PCN (Product Change Notification) process to alert all customers.

Will there be any changes to EDI maps, mailboxes or connections?

No. In an effort to limit impact on your EDI resources, you should continue to transact as you are today. For Maxim parts, continue using the same connection, maps, DUNS number, EDI ship to codes, part numbers and vendor account numbers. For Analog Devices parts, do the same as well. Analog Devices will eventually combine EDI programs. When that happens, we will work closely with you to ensure a seamless transition.
